## **Local and National Scholarships**

***Note: this is not an exhaustive list of scholarships! Keep your eyes and ears open for additional scholarship opportunities throughout the year***

### **Local (New Mexico) Scholarships**

#### **Sparx and Lorenzo Antonio Scholarship**

This scholarship is usually **due in March**. There are two scholarships offered:

- 1) Scholarship To Benefit APS and Albuquerque ENLACE Public High School Students (for use at UNM). *This scholarship is worth up to \$1,000*
- 2) Scholarship To Benefit New Mexico Public High School Students (for use at college of choice). *This scholarship is worth up to \$2,000*

#### **Sussman-Miller Educational Assistance Award**

This scholarship has two deadlines, one for students attending college *out of state* and one for students attending college *in state*. The out of state scholarship is usually **due in April**. The in state scholarship is usually **due in June**. *This scholarship is worth up to \$2,000*

#### **Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Scholarship Program**

The scholarship application is usually **due in January** (application becomes available in October) and will be considered for several different LANL scholarships. Any permanent resident of Northern New Mexico with at least a 3.25 cumulative unweighted GPA and scores of 19 on the ACT or 930 on the SAT (combined Math plus Critical Reading), who is enrolling in or currently attending an accredited post-secondary educational institution is eligible to apply. For the purpose of these scholarships, Northern New Mexico includes Los Alamos, Mora, Rio Arriba, San Miguel, Sandoval, Santa Fe, and Taos counties. ***Therefore, this scholarship is only open to Santa Fe scholars (sorry ABQ!)***

This scholarship is usually **due early in the academic year**. *It is worth \$1,000*

### **National Scholarships**

#### **Hispanic Scholarship Fund Scholarship**

This scholarship is usually **due in April**. *It is worth up to \$5,000*

#### **Daniels Fund Scholarship**

This scholarship is usually **due in November**. *It is a "full ride" scholarship, covering total cost of attendance at any college/university*

#### **Jack Kent Cooke Foundation College Scholarship**

This scholarship is usually **due in November**. This highly competitive scholarship includes:

- Up to \$40,000 per year to attend a four-year accredited undergraduate school
- Ability to pursue any area of study
- Personal advising about selecting a college and navigating financial aid
- Multifaceted advising about how to transition to college and maximize the college student experience

At a minimum, applicants must:

- Plan to graduate from a US high school in spring 2017
- Intend to enroll in an accredited four-year college beginning in fall 2017
- Earn a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.5 or above
- SAT combined critical reading and math score of 1200 (based on the old SAT scores) or above and/or ACT composite score of 26 or above
- Demonstrate significant unmet financial need. We will consider applicants with family income up to \$95,000. However, we anticipate that a majority of scholarship recipients will be eligible to receive a Pell grant

#### **Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation Scholarship**

This scholarship usually **opens in August**. *It is worth \$20,000*

Applicants must be:

- Current high school (or home-schooled) seniors attending school in the U.S.
- U.S. Citizens, U.S. Nationals, U.S. Permanent Residents, Refugees, Asylum-seekers, Cuban-Haitian Entrants, or Humanitarian Parolees
- Anticipating completion of high school diploma at the time of application
- Planning to pursue a degree at an accredited U.S. post-secondary institution
